Greetings on behalf of the LEDSC Executive Board! As Vice President of the LEDSC, I am writing to inform you that applications for candidate positions for the 2023–2024 school year are now open. Students interested in any of the five positions: President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, or District Liaison must attain at least one year of high school student council experience in high school. No more than 2 students from each school may run. Candidates must fill out the application and send it to ledscvicepresident@gmail.com by Monday, January 9th, 2023. Candidates are also required to attend two district meetings before being interviewed.

Upon submitting the application, each candidate, in addition to their adviser, must be interviewed by the LEDSC Credentials Committee. The candidate interview session will take place on **Thursday, February 16th, 2023** at Carbondale Community High School at 10am. *Business attire is required*. Based on the interviews and a review of applications from the Credentials Committee, each candidate will be awarded a recommendation status in order to ensure qualified officers are elected.

Officers in the LEDSC are required to carry out many duties, which are outlined in the LEDSC Constitution. Officers are also required to attend monthly district meetings. Attendance at the IASC State Convention is also highly encouraged.

Running for district office is an excellent way to become better involved and share your ideas on how to improve our district. We encourage any student interested in running for office to apply.
