Hello. We hope you are having an amazing school year. As the Vice President of the LEDSC, one of my responsibilities is to chair the Credentials Committee. I am pleased to inform you that the district is now accepting applications from students who wish to join the LEDSC Credentials Committee. The purpose of the Credentials Committee is to interview candidates running for the LEDSC Executive Board. This process is important in selecting qualified candidates to represent our district and serve on the Executive Board. The committee structure has been modeled around the IASC Credentials Committee expectations. The Credentials Committee is responsible for awarding each candidate a recommendation status that will be announced before the candidate gives their speech at the District Convention.

Each school may have up to **three students** apply to be a part of the committee; however, we have a limited number of spots, and students will be chosen to achieve an equal balance of representation of all schools willing to participate. Students wishing to participate may **NOT** run for office themselves.

If selected to serve on the Credentials Committee, members must attend the Credentials Workshop held at Marion High School at 10 am on **January 18th, 2024**. Students will learn how to interview prospective LEDSC board members at this workshop and prepare for the interviews held at Marion High School on **February 15th, 2024**. Committee members are expected to dress in appropriate business attire for both events.

Being a part of the Credentials Committee is a great opportunity for every school to be represented in the election process and become more involved at the district level.
